The IU Bloomington Office of Sorority and Fraternity Life receives budget support from two sources: the Division of Student Affairs and the Greek Fee. The Greek Fee is assessed to all members of sororities and fraternities. For the 2021-2022 academic year, the fee is \$40.00 per semester for Interfraternity Council/Panhellenic Association members and \$25.00 per semester for Multicultural Greek Council/National Pan-Hellenic Council members. The Greek Fee is an important component of ensuring the IU sorority and fraternity community has staff support, educational programs, leadership development and assessment efforts to meet the community standards and values.
